Nutrition (3 credits)- Transfer course must be a stand-alone Nutrition course.

Lower Division English (3 credits)- Transfer course must be a research based writing class. Most ENG 101 courses will not transfer to meet this requirement.

Computer Science (3 credits)- Transfer course must have subject areas in hardware, software, file sharing and ethics.

Fine Arts (3 credits)- Transfer course in Art, Music, Drama, or Creative Writing.

Humanities (3 credits)- Transfer course in History, Philosophy, Literature, Logic, or World Religion.

Upper Division English (3 credits)- Transfer course must be a 300 (junior) level course from a four year institution. Most students will need to complete this course.

Integrated Learning Community (4 credits)- This is a UGF specific course that must be completed at UGF. All students without a previous bachelor's degree will need to complete this course.

This is a sample planner that assumes the student only has A&P and Micro as transferable courses from their previous college. Most students will have more courses that will transfer in to meet the requirements. This document is used to plan each students' Pre-BSN Program and will include an accurate RN-BSN Program start date. UGF will be admitting students twice a year starting in 2018. All outstanding courses must be completed at time of application. Registration for the Spring 2017 semester will open November 10, 2016.
